a world was happiness flow through air;



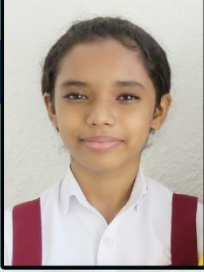
OUR ENVIORNMENT

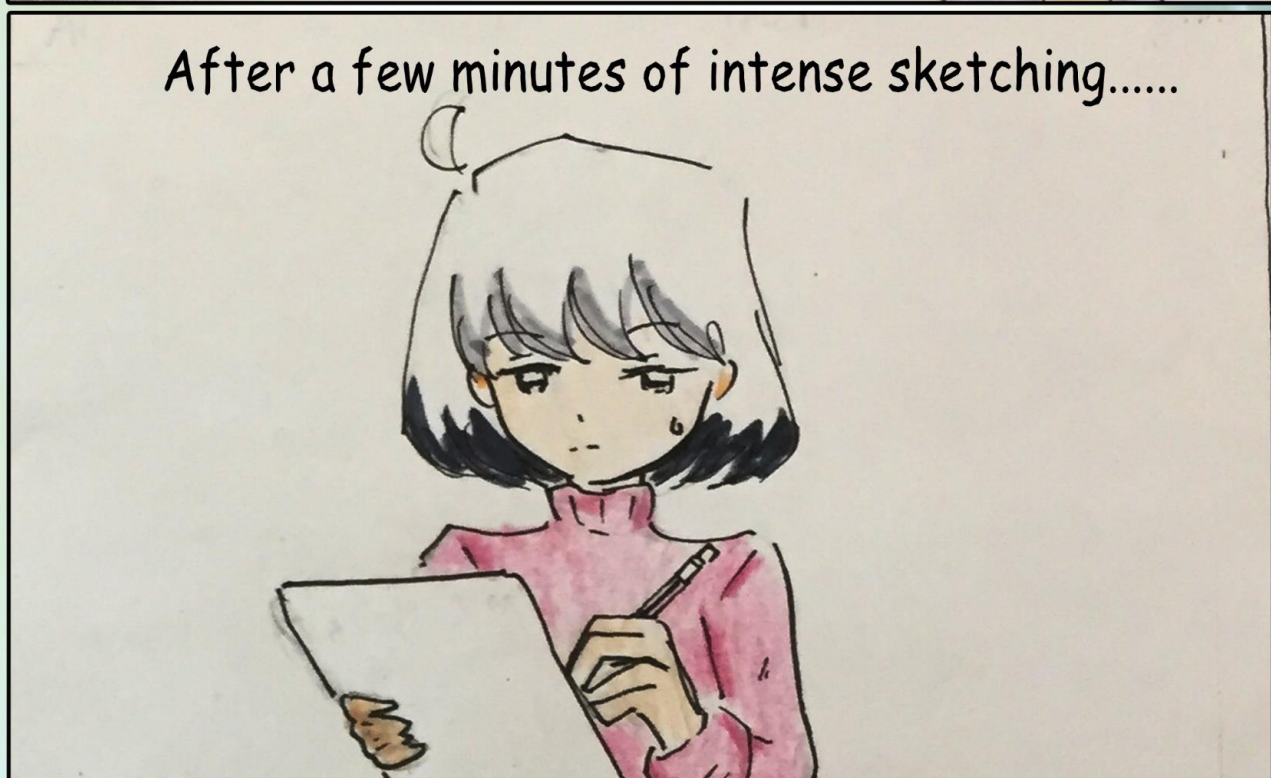

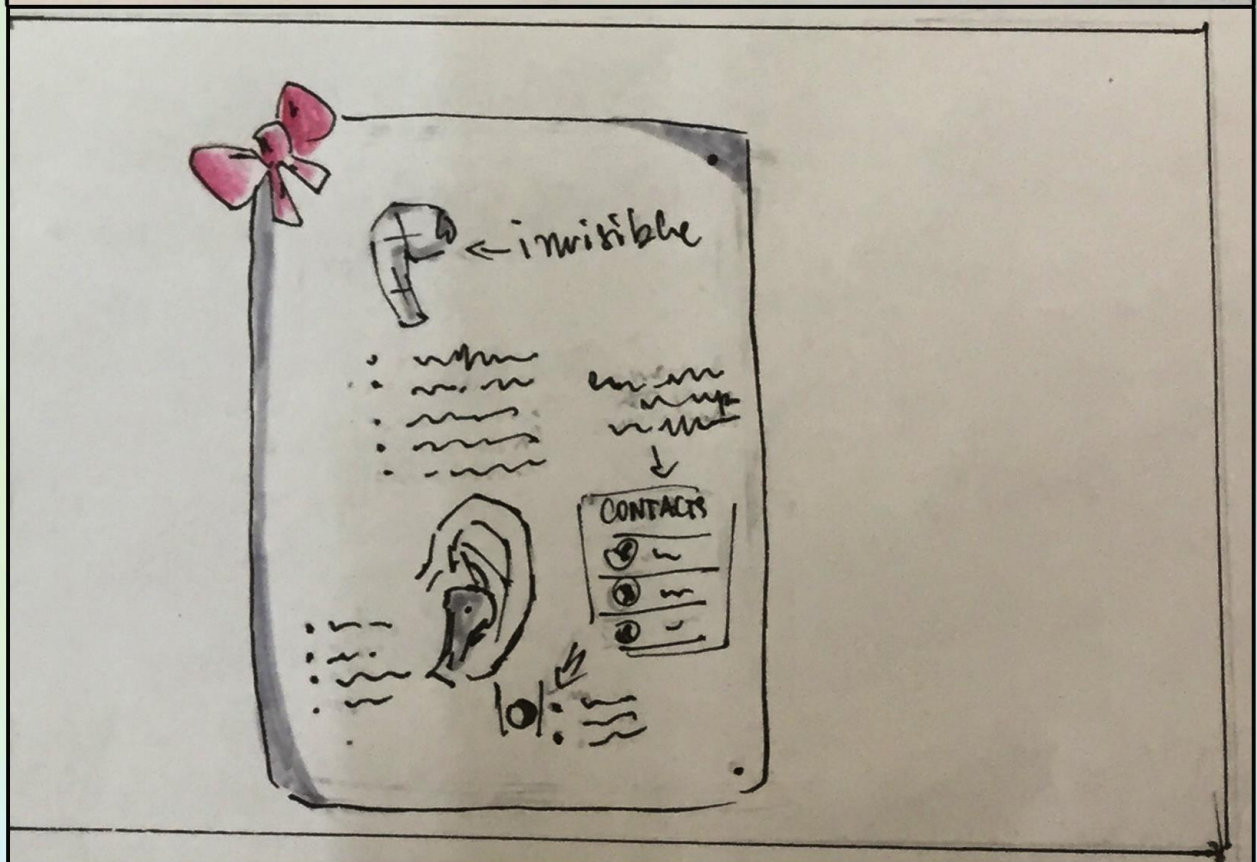
















MAGIC OF MUSIC

Music delights me- I even like dancing to it. One of the most common reasons why people listen to music is because it heals their heart and soul.

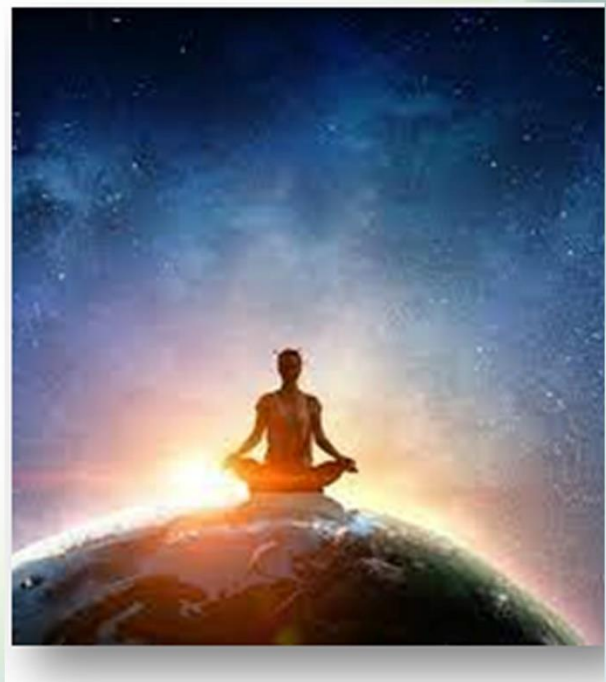

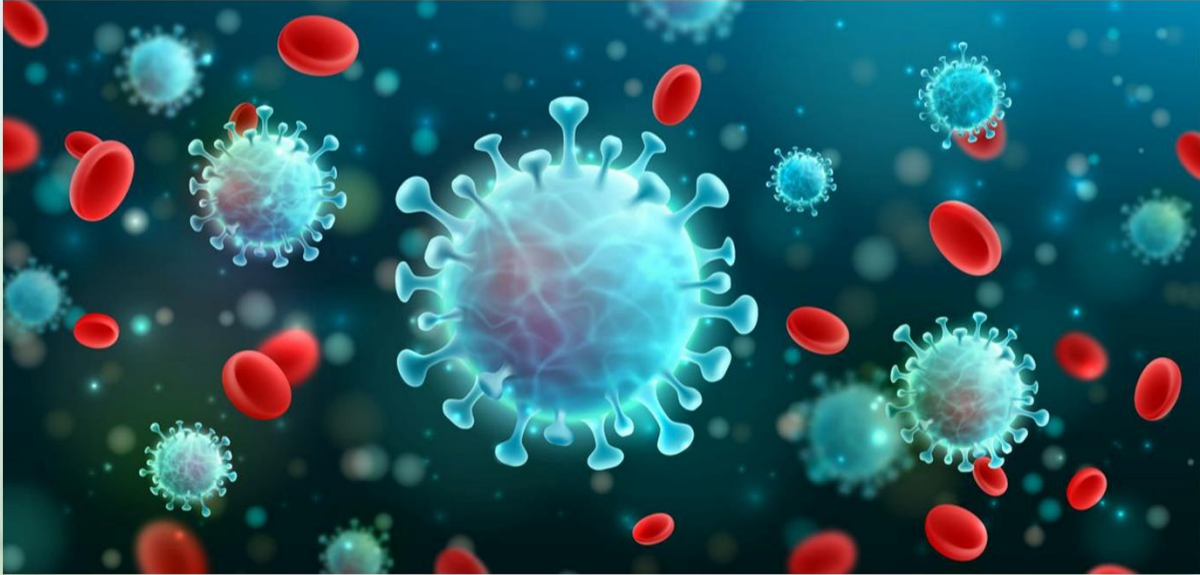
Rahul is this real or a dream, suddenly there was a sound and Aunj woke up and he was in his bed dreaming the candy world!!.

PREVENT COVID 19

"If you are not fully vaccinated against Covid 19,
Wear a face Mask
Maintain at least six feet of distance.
Avoid gatherings
Get Vaccinated when you are eligible.

Avoid close contact with people who are sick
Minimize touching your eyes, nose and mouth.

Wash your hands often with soap and water if soap and water are not readily available, use an alcohol -based sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol, covering all surfaces of your hands and rubbing them together until they feel dry.

10 INTERESTING FACTS ABOUT EARTH

1. The Earth's rotation is gradually slowing.

This deceleration is happening almost imperceptibly, at approximately 17 milliseconds per hundred years, although the rate at which it occurs is not perfectly uniform. This has the effect of lengthening our days, but it happens so slowly that it could be as much as 140 million years before the length of a day will have increased to 25 hours.

2. The Earth was once believed to be the Centre of the universe.

Due to the apparent movements of the Sun and planets in relation to their viewpoint, ancient scientists insisted that the Earth remained static, whilst other celestial bodies travelled in circular orbits around it. Eventually, the view that the Sun was at the Centre of the universe was postulated by Copernicus, though this is also not the case.

3. Earth has a powerful magnetic field.

This phenomenon is caused by the nickel-iron core of the planet, coupled with its rapid rotation. This field protects the Earth from the effects of solar wind.

4. There is only one natural satellite of the planet Earth.

As a percentage of the size of the body it orbits, the Moon is the largest satellite of any planet in our solar system. In real terms, however, it is only the fifth largest natural satellite.

5. Earth is the only planet not named after a god.

The other seven planets in our solar system are all named after Roman gods or goddesses. Although only Mercury, Venus, Mars, Jupiter and Saturn were named during ancient times, because they were visible to the naked eye, the Roman method of naming planets was retained after the discovery of Uranus and Neptune.

6. The Earth is the densest planet in the Solar System.

This varies according to the part of the planet; for example, the metallic core is denser than the crust. The average density of the Earth is approximately 5.52 grams per cubic centimeter.

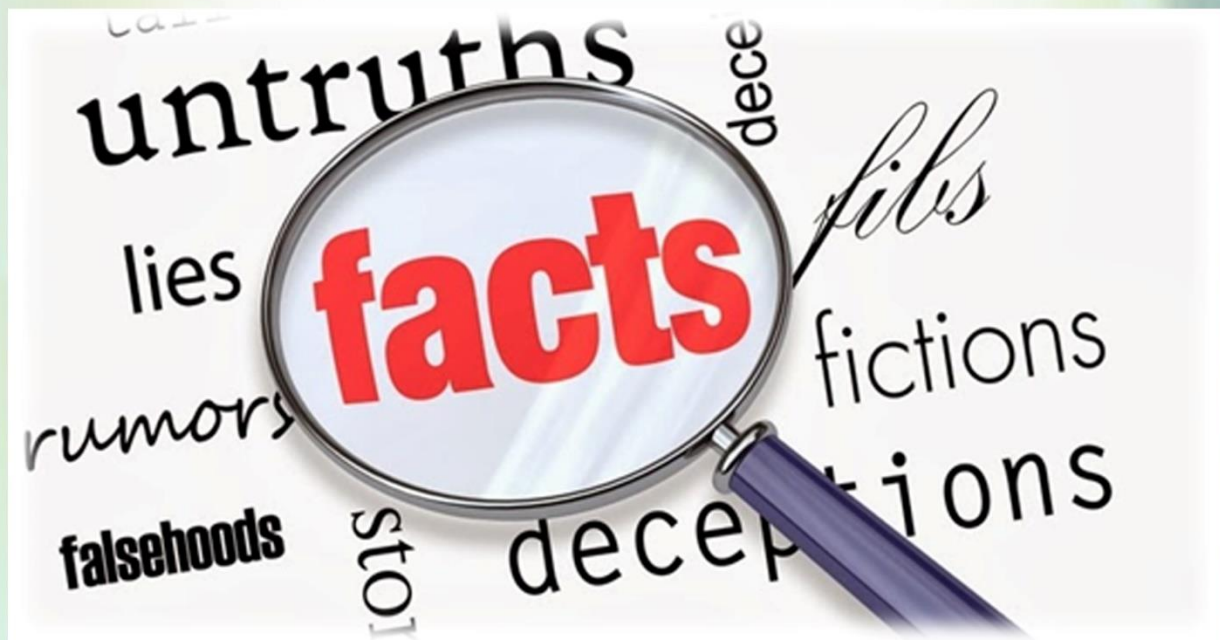
7. Earth isn't perfectly round.

It's about 0.3% thicker. It's not much, so when you see a photo of Earth, it appears round. But it's just barely not.

8. The driest place on Earth is near the ocean. The Atacama Desert in northern Chile is the driest place on Earth. It is said that a city there went without rain for 400 years! And yet, this desert is right next to the biggest body of water on Earth, the Pacific Ocean.

9. Sea levels have changed in the past. During the last Ice Age, so much water was trapped in icy glaciers that the sea level dropped by as much as 390 feet (120 meters). That's about as tall as building 40 stories high! Long before that, the sea level was actually much higher than it is now. It was as much as 230 feet higher. There are parts of land today that used to be far beneath the ocean waters.

10. Earth has other "moons."
Besides our moon, there are two other objects in space that orbit near Earth. They're not truly "moons," but they are there! One of them is an asteroid that follows Earth as we orbit around the sun. It's called Cruithne. A different asteroid orbits the sun near us but its orbit is horseshoe-shaped, so it only gets near Earth every 95 years. This one is called Asteroid 2002 AA29. It has a weird name.





FACTS OF SPACE

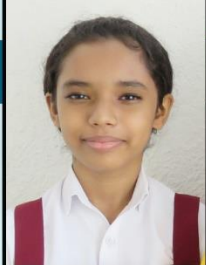
- ❖ Mercury & Venus are the only 2 planets in our solar system that have no moons.
- ❖ If a star passes too close to a black hole, it can be torn apart.
- ❖ The highest mountain discovered is the Olympus Mons, which is located on Mars.
- ❖ The Whirlpool Galaxy (M51) was the first celestial object identified as being spiral.
- ❖ A light-year is the distance covered by light in a single year.
- ❖ The Milky Way galaxy is 105,700 light-years wide.
- ❖ Footprints left on the Moon won't disappear as there is no wind.
- ❖ The Martian day is 24 hours 39 minutes and 35 seconds long.

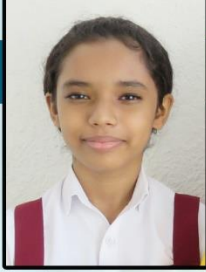
